Education Française Greater Houston is a Houston-based non-profit organization that offers:

- **Français Langue Maternelle (FLAM)** courses for Francophone children between the ages of 4 and 18 attending American schools. The courses improve students' oral and written French skills, encourage them to become bilingual and help them maintain a connection to the French and francophone culture, even when French has become their secondary language.
- **French as a Second Language (FLE)** courses for Anglophone children between the ages of 4 and 18 who wish to learn French as a second language.
- **A French immersion camp** every summer for children between the ages of 5 and 10.

Primary tasks of the Cultural Events Coordinator:

You will play a part in EFGH's mission of promoting the French language by organizing 3–4 cultural field trips per year that are appropriate for students.

Examples of cultural field trips may include a visit to a museum (MFAH volunteers are in charge of visits in French for students), exhibition, show or French artist's studio after French class on Saturday. You will be in charge of overseeing the event from start to finish.

Required skills:

- Commitment to the EFGH's mission and values.
- Ideal candidates are passionate about culture, have good communication skills and are capable of organizing cultural events.
- Be open-minded and have excellent interpersonal skills.
- Self-discipline and organization.
- Fluent in French and English.

The Cultural Events Coordinator is an ongoing and non-paid position. The volunteer will work as needed.
